Make sure your hands are dry before touching a switch.



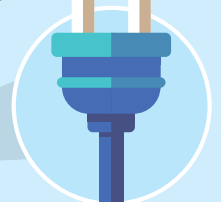
Use recommended C class fire extinguisher.



Be cautious when using any electrical device like a hair dryer near water.



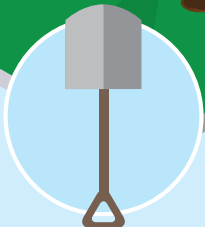
Childproof your home with outlet covers or plastic caps.



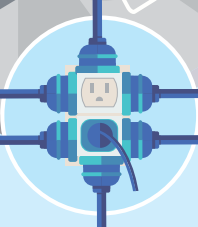
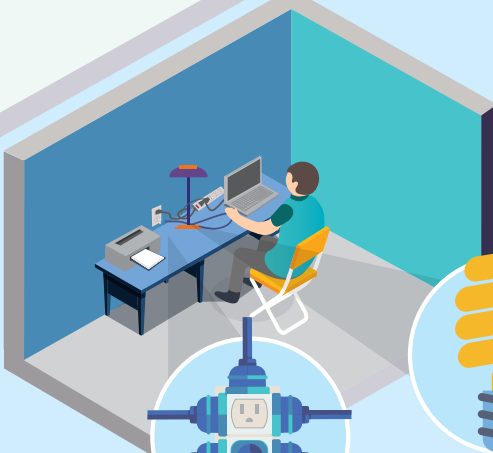
Pull the plug, not the cord.



Look up before moving a metal ladder to avoid contact with power lines.



Call 811 before digging in your yard.



Remember that overloaded outlets can cause a fire.



Follow the maximum wattage for light fixtures to reduce the risk of overheating.
